

Class Rank & Grade Point Average

Rank is based on the first seven consecutive semesters during the student's high school career with the final four (beginning with the 2nd semester of his/her sophomore year) of the seven semesters having been completed at the school from which he/she is graduating. **It is important to note that class rank includes the first semester progress of the student's senior year.** To determine your unweighted GPA, total quality points are divided by the total number of courses attempted. If you have taken Advanced Placement courses, you should be aware that your grade had 10 points. For an unweighted GPA, you should calculate those AP grades with the 10 points removed. Many students get confused about what it means to have a true 4.0 GPA. Simply stated, a student with a 4.0 GPA has never earned any grade below an 'A' on all high school coursework.
